- Overhead tanks and water sumps, septic tanks shall be hermetically sealed and scientifically closed and shall not be breeding sources of mosquitoes.
- Drinking water shall be chlorinated and shall have 0.5 ppm of residual chlorine. If any other water disinfection method is followed, should have adequate documented maintenance.

- > Fly / Mosquitoes breeding shall not be permitted within school premises.
- > Hot lime wash / color wash to be done once a year.
- "No Smoking and No Spitting Zone" and that "Smoking or Spitting here is an Offence" in Tamil and English shall be displayed.
- No sale of tobacco within the radius of 100 meters of the educational institution. (Head Master / Principal should ensure)
- Any school absenteeism of school students in mass or for a long period of time due to sickness by cold, fever, rashes etc. should be reported to the local health authorities as early as possible.
- Timely vaccinations as prescribed by the Government should be done for the children at appropriate age by the Government health care providers or private health care providers (proof to be produced in the prescribed format).

This certificate issued is liable to be cancelled at any time on infringement of any of the above said conditions and for improper maintenance of sanitation, improper maintenance of building as well as toilets in the school.
